



Track Rules

Drivers

- Check into race control when you arrive at the track.
- Ensure your track fees are paid on arrival and before your car goes onto the track.
- During qualifying, you should let the faster drivers pass.
- Keep your mouth closed on the rostrum.
- The race director is God, race control always has the final say.
- If your car is being marshalled - ensure the brakes are applied.
- Do not shout, swear or abuse the marshals.
- Slow down when a marshal is on the track.
- Do not cut corners during a race - to do so will incur a 10 sec penalty in the pits - if you don't pit you will be disqualified.
- Do not cross the pit unless during a heat or final.
- Clear the pit area immediately after you have driven your heat / final.

Marshals

- Marshal like you would like to be marshalled. Watch the section of track for problems NOT the race action! No smoking, no drinking, no mobile phones, no eating, no chatting.
- Do not marshal a car if the wheels are turning - raise both arms to inform the driver.
- Must always wear yellow vests while carrying out your duties.
- Anyone who does not fulfil their marshaling duties will lose their best heat result.

General

- Please do not litter - take it home with you and dispose of safely.
- Only marshals or pit men are allowed on the track during a race.
- Bad or insulting behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in a suspension from the track for the rest of the day - race results will be null and void.
- General Public are not allowed inside the tire wall or perimeter fence.
